Dear Parents and Guardians,

Thank you for helping North Putnam Schools make certain our children travel safely to and from school. The Transportation Department and central office administrators met with the Supervisor of the Highway Department in early January, and snow routes were finalized on February 4. The purpose of snow routes is to make certain the roads buses travel have been plowed and salted. By limiting the number of bus stop locations, the highway department can dedicate their resources and manpower to the roads being traveled.

The condition of many of the roads has not changed since the ice storm; many country roads are still covered in two or more inches of ice. The implementation of snow routes has made it necessary for some families to make special arrangements for their children to be dropped-off and picked-up at the snow route location. I appreciate your patience and assistance!

You should have received a phone call from your bus driver on February 4 or February 5 with bus stop locations and pick-up/drop-off times. If you have not received a phone call from your bus driver, please call the North Putnam Transportation Department at (765-522-6220). You will also find information regarding bus routes and pick-up/drop-off times attached to this letter.
