

The following is the safety plan at the high school and middle school for tomorrow and the rest of the school week so you are aware of the process we are using to protect our students and staff.

The threatening message found on the rest room stall contained no specific information or reference to any specific person or groups. Whether the message was meant to be a sick joke or something else, we are treating it as real and taking our efforts to protect our students very seriously.

Representatives from state, county, and local police agencies will be at school in the morning. All students who drive and who ride buses will enter the main door of the high school and will be inspected by school administration and police. Middle school students who are riders will enter middle school door 7 with the same process.

The high school administration instituted safety level 2 today and will continue with level 2 for the rest of the week. Safety level 2 keeps students in class and out of hallways during class periods, classroom doors will remain shut and locked, windows and blinds will remain closed and covered, and classroom instruction will continue. Students who need to use rest room facilities or the clinic will be escorted by an administrator or staff member.

We will have law enforcement presence in the building for the remainder of the week or until school administrators feel assured the threat situation has ended.
