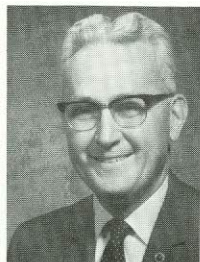


Is this H₂ O?

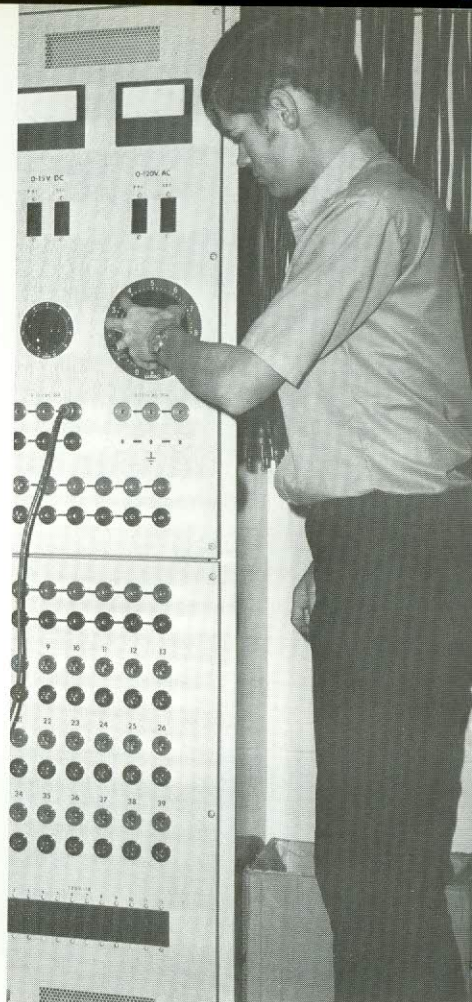
