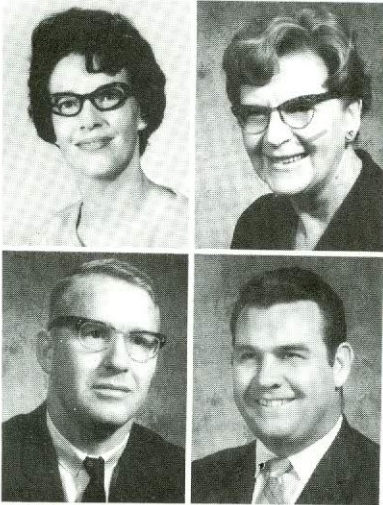
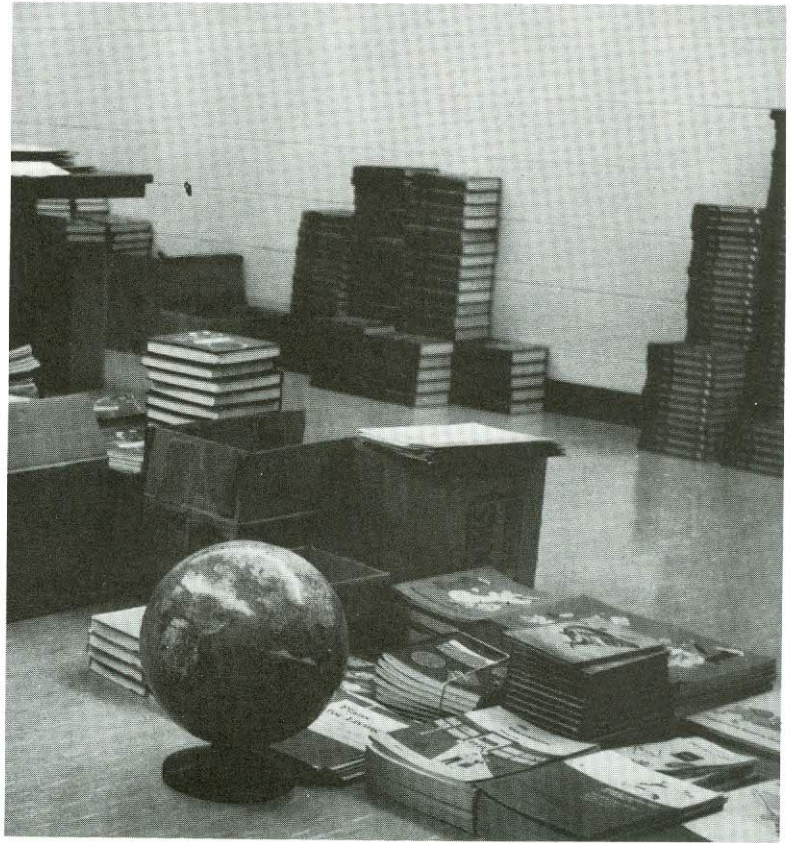

Our American Government

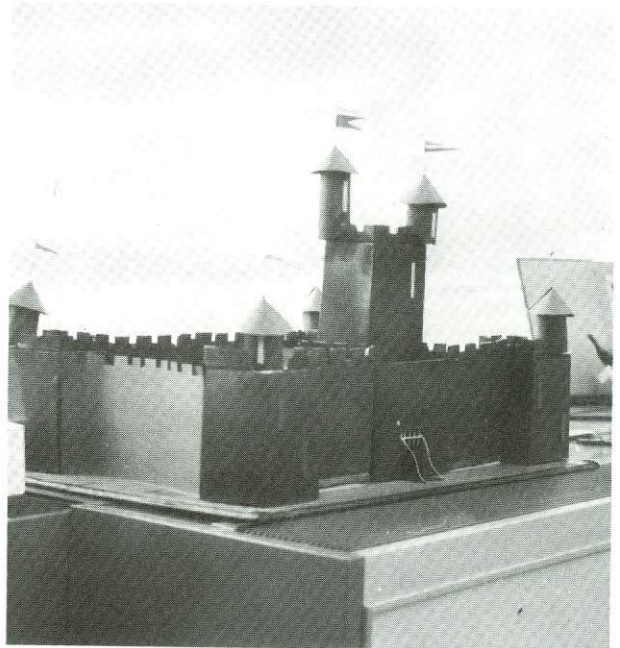
President Thistlewaite? This was the case when government students became House Members and Senators last winter. Every second, third and sixth periods these students created, voted on, or passed, and killed many bills.
