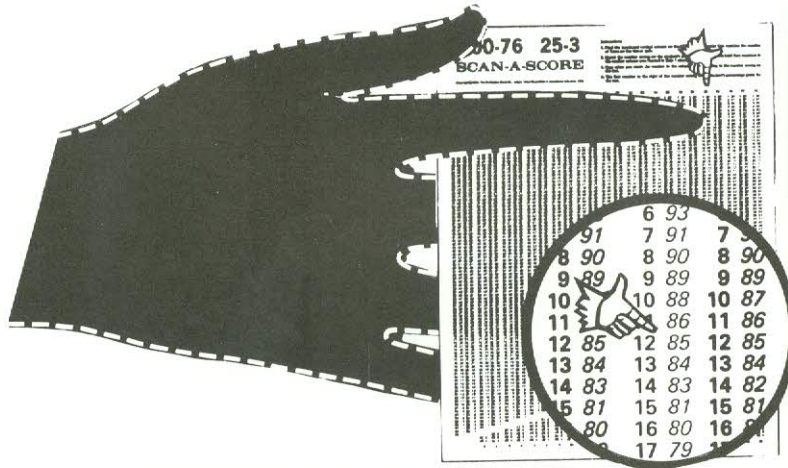


## We advised.
