

## We had problems.

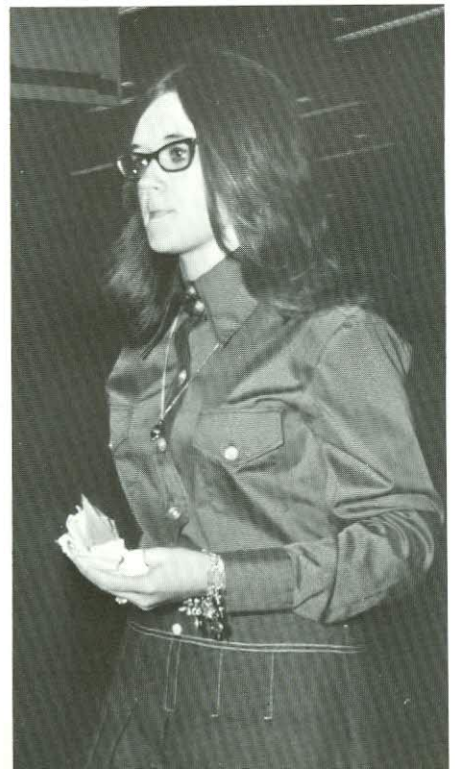
Yes, we had problems at North Putnam--general math, algebra, geometry, and trigonometry problems. This year students didn't have any answers from last year in their books, because there were new math books.
