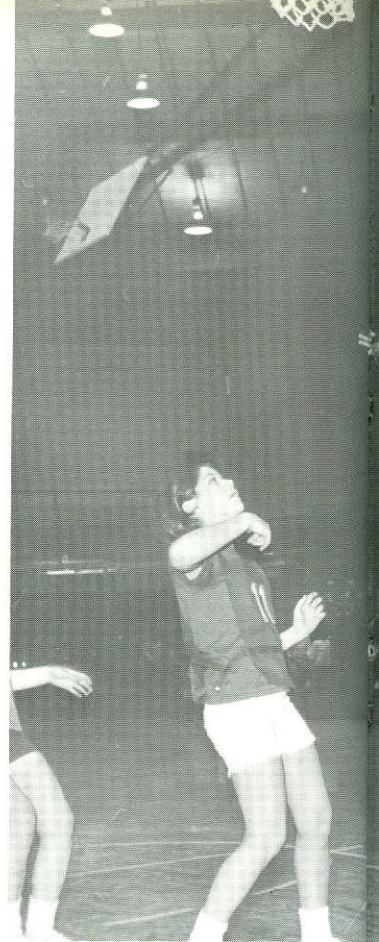


Zoners—Aminals— Pacers—River Rats— Intramural teams?
