The sophomores of N.P.H.S. were easily recognized by many activities in which they participated.

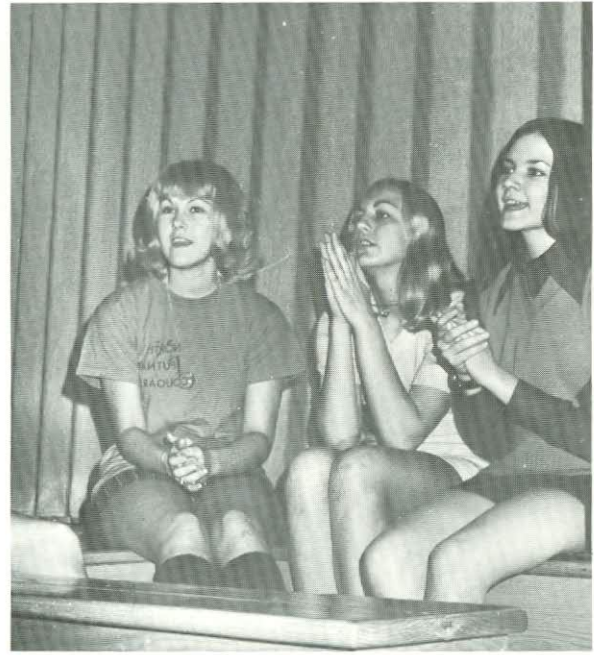
Their lives ranged from congruent triangles to broken dates and even to miserly Silas Marner.
