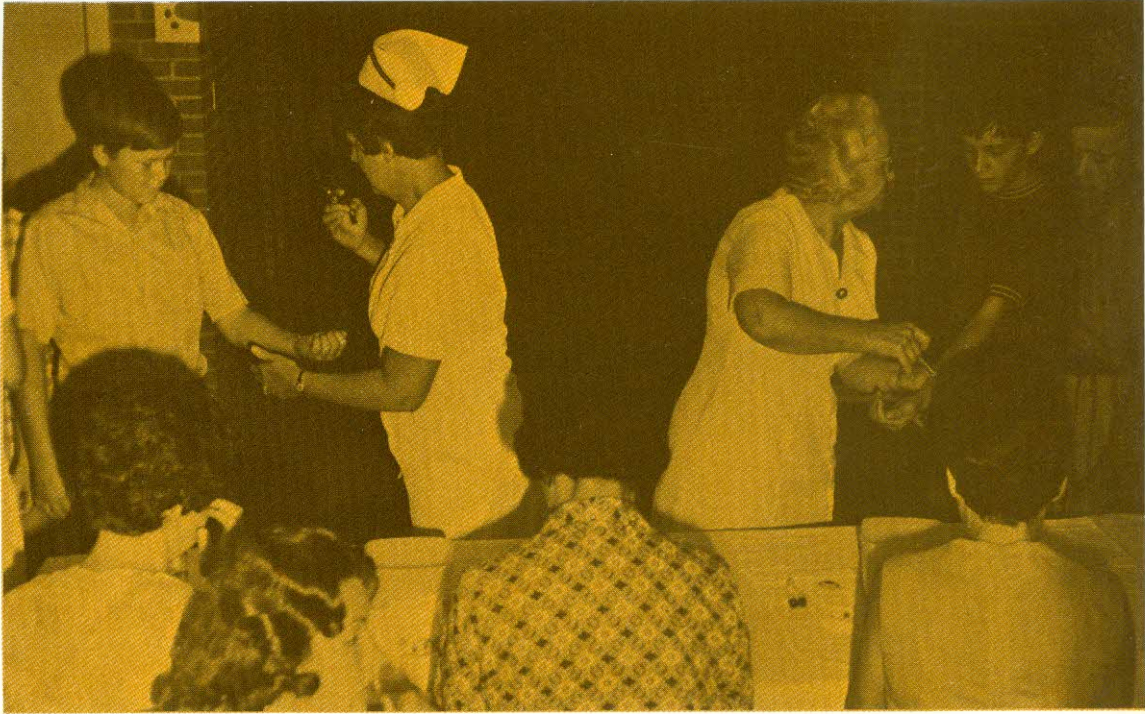


Mrs. Bee and her helpers attempted to reassure nervous students as they gave them a TB test. This was a very valuable
