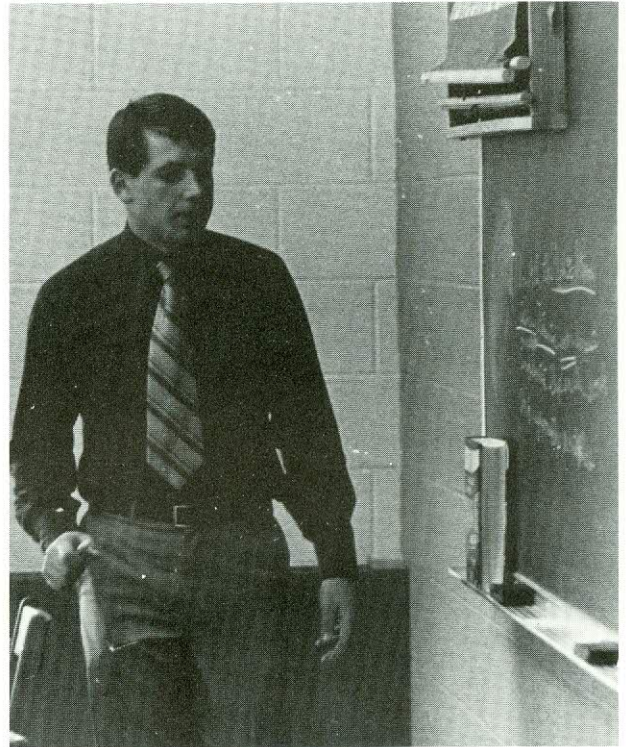


READING, WRITING AND SPELLING
