

Band Leaders March On



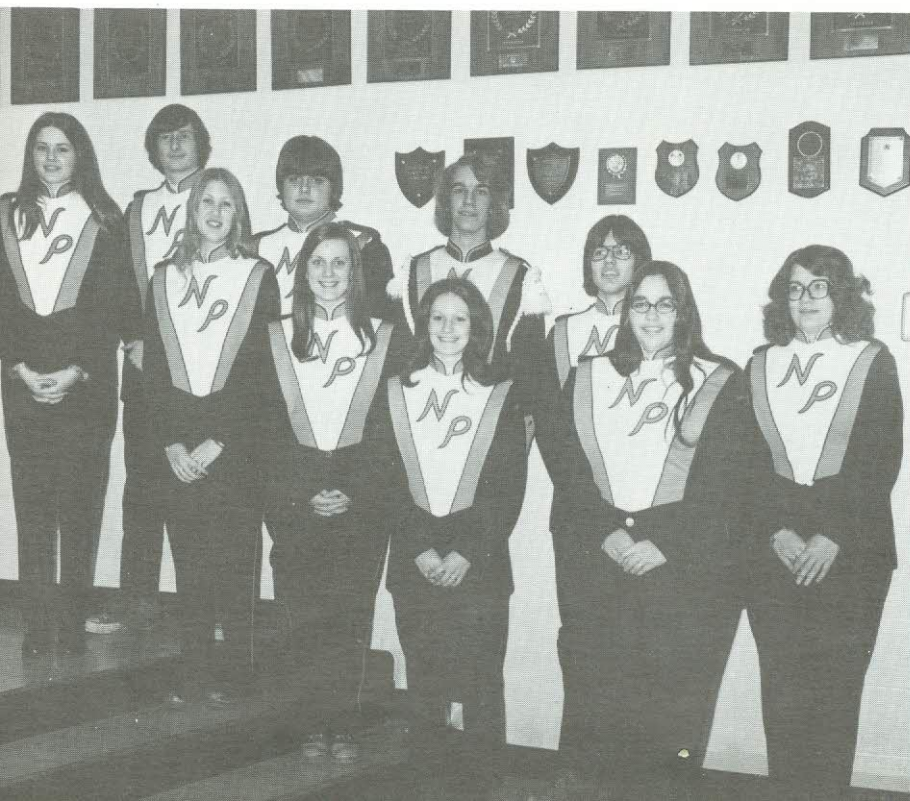
