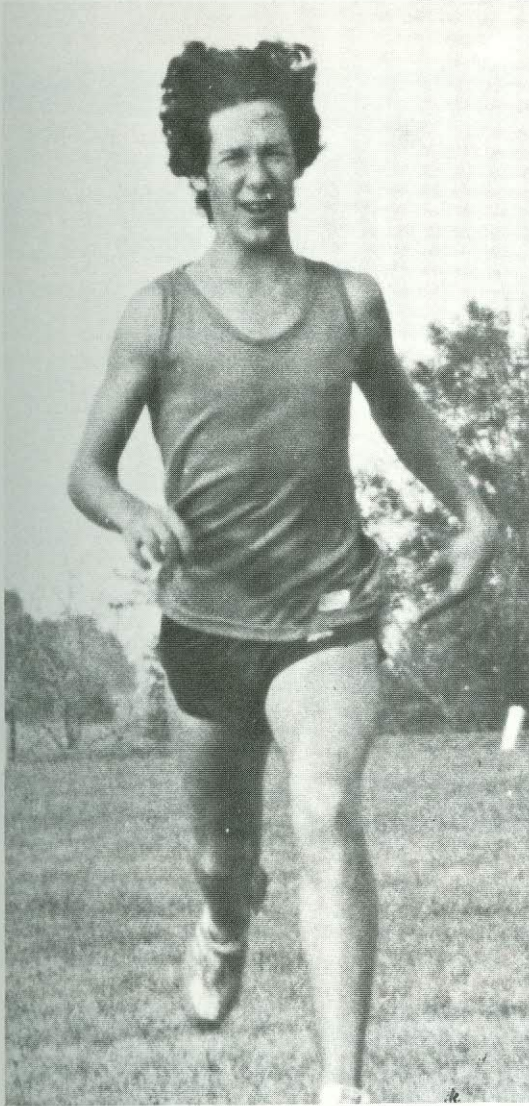


Quality Overcomes Quantity
