## Junior High Basketball

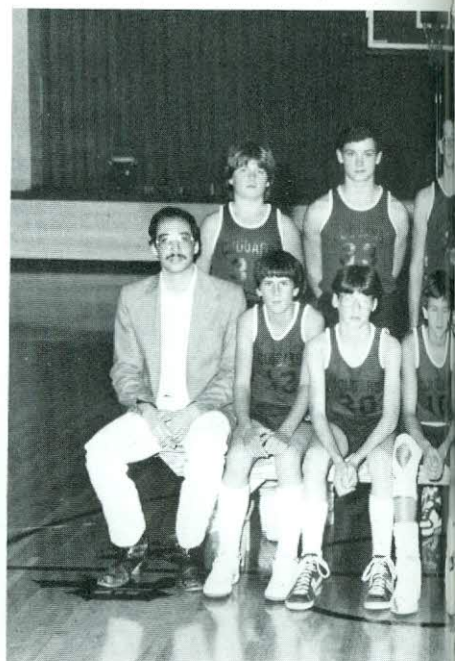
