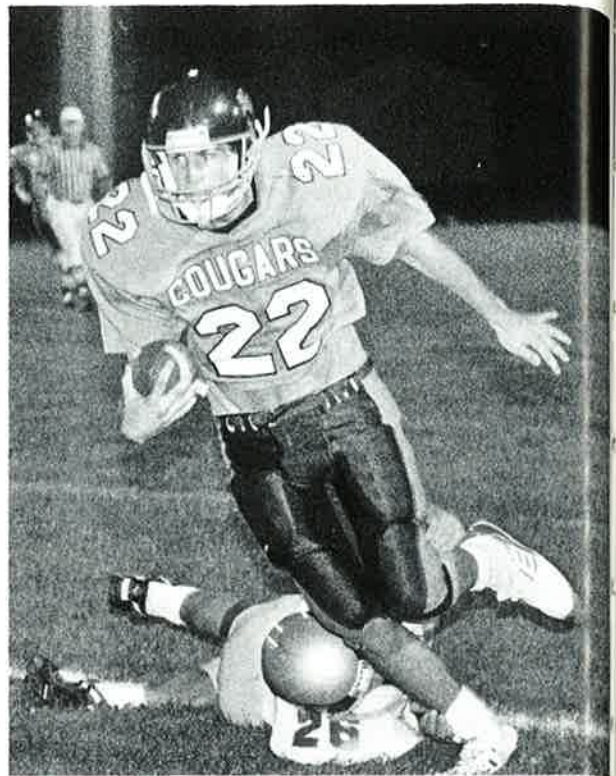


"The 1991 football season surpassed many expectations and fell short of others." Coach King
