

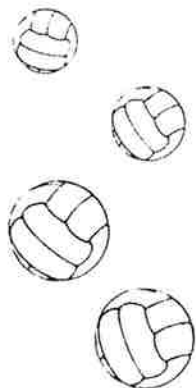


Kris Oliver bumps the ball.
