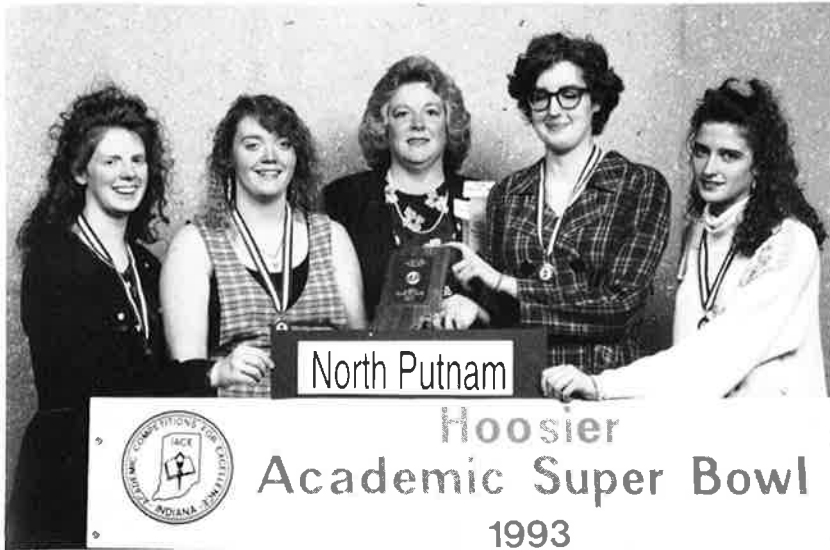


English Team Takes Spotlight
