

Dedication

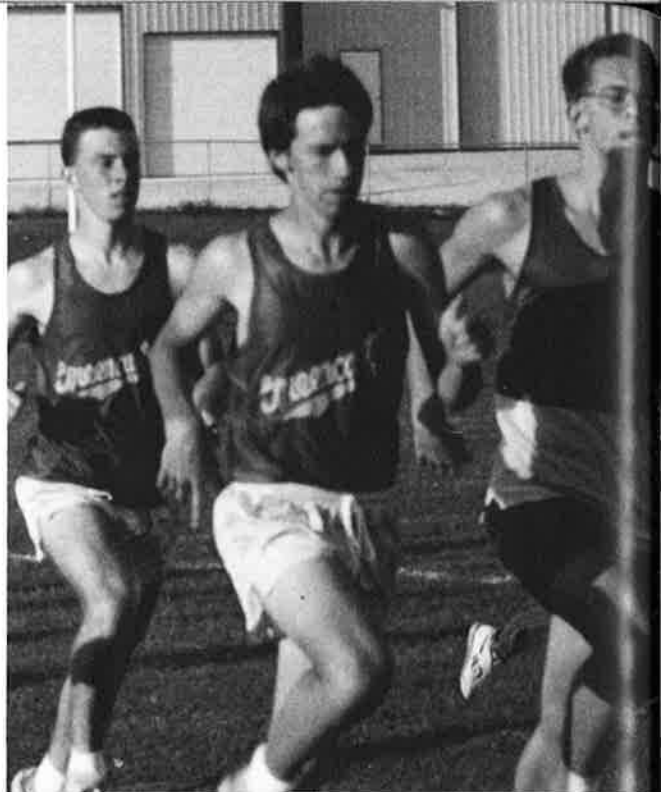
