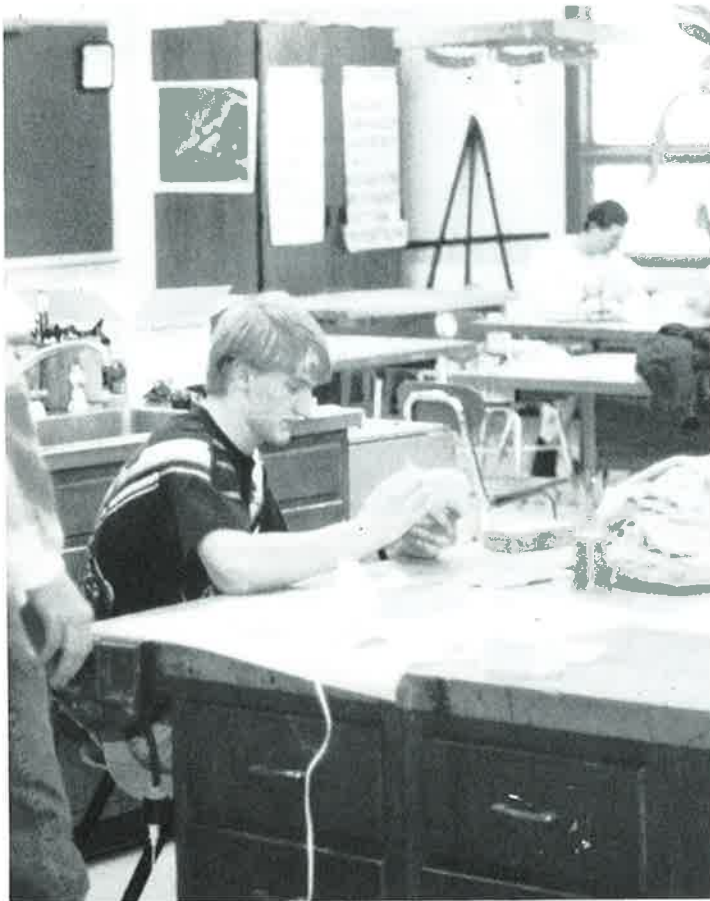


# HANDS ON!
