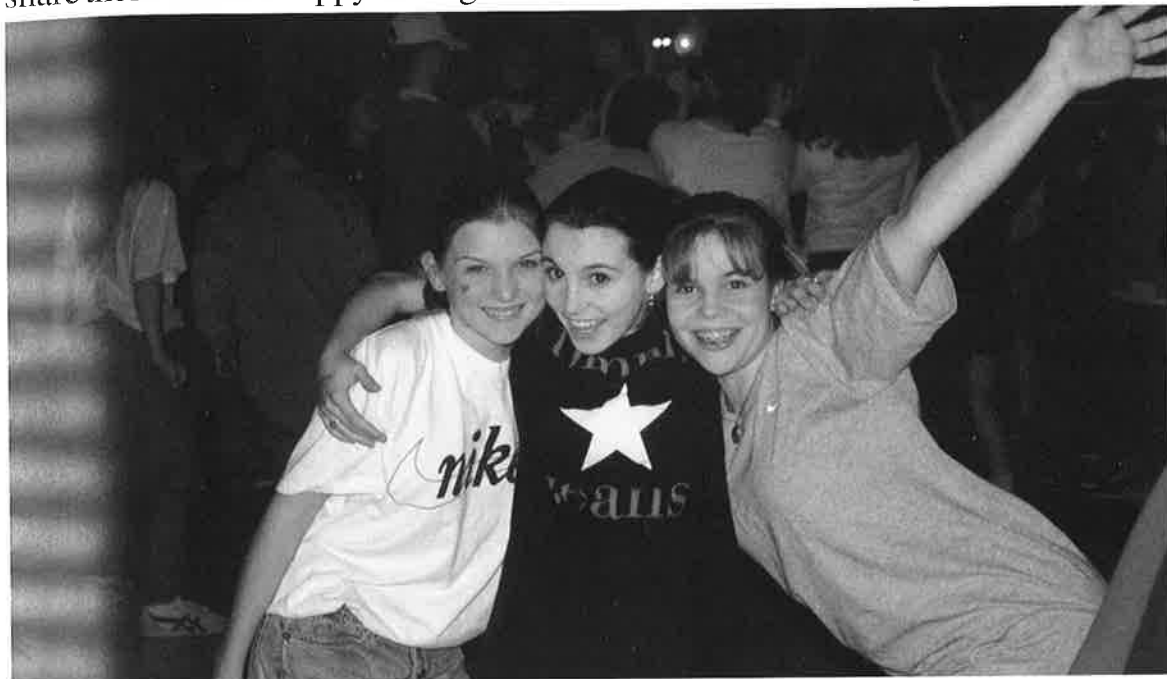


FRIENDS
