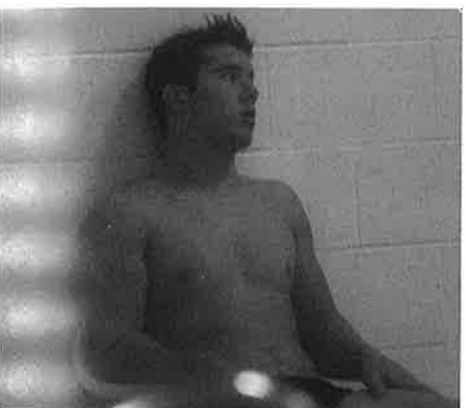


Let'em play
