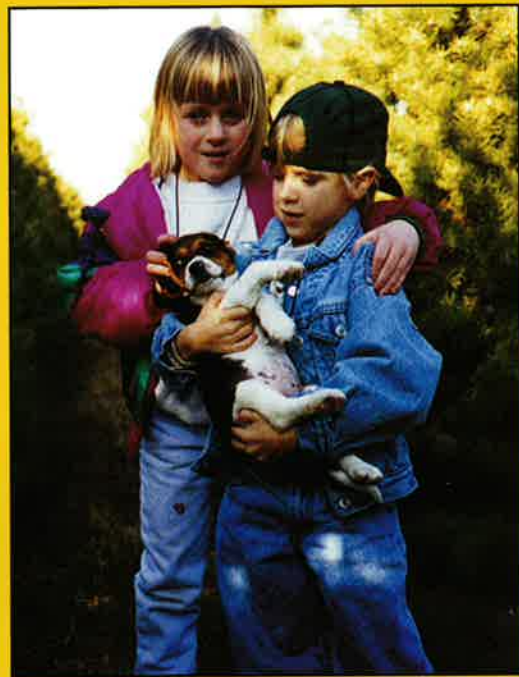


Chelsea Greene
