North Putnam Schools H1N1 Flu Vaccine Clinic Monday, November 30, 2009

The Putnam County Health Department in partnership with the Putnam County Hospital will be conducting an H1N1 flu vaccine clinic on Monday, November 30, for children ages 6 months to 19 years.

The clinic will be held at the North Putnam Middle School from the hours of 9:00 A.M. to 12:00 noon. The H1N1 “shot” vaccine will be available for High School and Middle School students at this time. All students will need to have a vaccination consent form signed by a legal guardian in order to receive the vaccine. An evening clinic will be held from the hours of 3:30 P.M. to 7:00 P.M. for children younger than middle school age and other children whose parents need to be present. Both the H1N1 vaccine “shot” and the nasal “mist” vaccine will be available at this time.

The Health Department urges the parents of children who have already received the H1N1 vaccine to ask the school system to remove submitted consent forms and insure their children do not receive a duplicate vaccination.
