



PARENT/TEACHER CONFERENCES

Bainbridge Elementary will be holding their Parent/Teacher Conferences October 27, 2011 from 1:00-7:00 p.m. that day. Teachers will be contacting parents to set up conferences this day. We encourage you to come into the school to meet with your child's teacher, or if that is not possible, you may request a phone conference or chat through email. Please contact your child's teacher as to your preference.

The teacher will tell you about your child's progress since the beginning of the school year. You will discuss the student's strengths and weaknesses, and provide suggestions or ideas you can use at home to help your child.

You can provide information that will help the teacher better understand your child. This is a time for you and the teacher to plan for a successful school year. After the conference, tell your child what was discussed. Be positive! The better your child feels about himself/herself the better he/she will do in school!

Students will be attending school on the morning of the 27th and the 28th.

Students will have breakfast and lunch at school. Car riders will be dismissed at 12:15 and bus riders will be released at 12:30. This will take place on Thursday and Friday. If you have any questions, please call the office.

Please contact your child's teacher to set up a time when you can discuss your child's progress. This is an important piece in our parent/teacher commitment to your child's education!



TRANSPORTATION

Parents, please do NOT call the school after 2:00 p.m. to change transportation for your child. This is an extremely busy time for teachers and the office. Parents are to send notes to school the day of the change. The notes will go to the office so the secretaries may write reminder notes and bus passes. Children should know the night before or the morning of the change. They should not be coming to the office

during dismissal because they do not know where they need to go after school.. This is very stressful and frightening for your child when they are not sure where they are to go if their transportation changes often. The bus drivers take the safety of your child very seriously as well, and it is difficult to be sure the child is in the correct place when transportation changes often.
