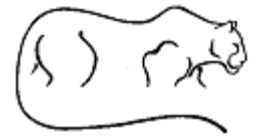

Prepared for Winter Weather?

Be certain to bundle up the kiddies for school each day as this winter looks to be as cold and snowy as last year. Here are a few helpful reminders about surviving the winter months:

1. Hats and gloves are a must. On days that we can go outside, we will try to be outdoors to give kiddos plenty of fresh air and exercise. Typically, we will not go outside for recess if the wind chill dips much below 30 degrees.
2. School doors open for car riders and walkers at 8:00 am. Please do not drop off students earlier than 8:00 am. On delay days, doors open at 10:00.
3. Encourage students to bring a sweatshirt to school to keep in their locker.
4. Shorts are not allowed to be worn to school until spring. Generally, it is warm enough after spring break for students to begin wearing shorts again.
5. Be sure we have your correct phone number in Harmony so you will receive delay or cancellation notification calls. Also, delay/closing information will be given to local TV and radio stations. You can also find this information on our Facebook page and school website.
6. Wear closed-toe shoes and socks each day to keep your feet warm.
7. Encourage students to bring study materials home each night. Putting off homework in anticipation of school being closed the next day is a good way to get behind.
8. Know the make-up days:

April 3

April 6

May 28

School will be in session on the above days depending on the number of closings that occur. If we do not have a closing prior to the day listed, it will be a day off of school. If we miss more than these four days, additional days will be added after May 28.
