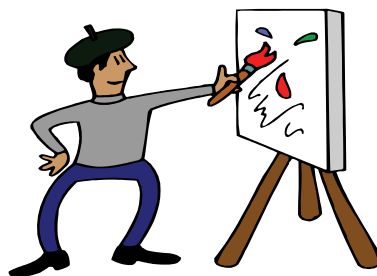

# UPGRADED MEDIA SOFTWARE



North Putnam schools recently received an upgrade to their library software. Follett's Destiny software provides many upgrades. Students can now look for books through a more visually-friendly screen with more search options. They can also rate and review books. Users can search for a book based on lexile ratings. Lexiles provide a more accurate way to search for a book based on the student's reading level. Destiny will also help our schools implement digital books over the upcoming years. Finally, users can search for a book at any of the North Putnam Community school's media centers. The last version of software was used for over 15 years so the media centers should be set for years to come.
