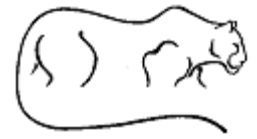

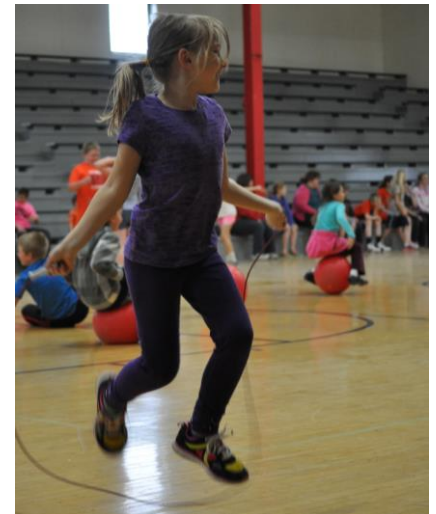

Testing Schedule for ISTEP+ Part 2

The second part of ISTEP+ will begin on April 23. Each grade level will take a portion of the test over 6-7 days. The number of minutes spent testing each day will vary. On most days, students will test between 40-100 minutes. If students are taking more than one test in a day, a break will be built into the schedule between tests.

Attendance each day remains an important part of your child's success on ISTEP+. Though we have built in plenty of time for making up any missed sessions, students perform better when they take the test at the same time as their peers. Please try to limit the amount of time your child might miss by scheduling appointments after school or after May 8.
