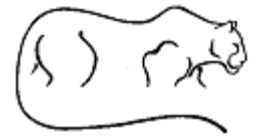

EARTH DAY HAPPENINGS

During the month of April, students at Roachdale were treated to Earth Day presentations sponsored by the Indiana Department of Environmental Management. 3rd & 4th grade had lessons on Land Quality; learning about landfills and where trash goes. The 1st & 2nd grades had presentations on Recycling.

The 2nd grade class participated in a community service project picking up trash around town. Together, the classes collected over 36.5 pounds of trash. That was close to 1 pound per student!

3rd & 4th grade students received trees for Earth Day that were donated by the Indiana Department of Natural Resources & Parke County REMC.
