

**Annual AHERA Notification**  
**By North Putnam Community Schools**  
**For the years 2013/2014**

Under the asbestos hazard emergency response act (AHERA) of 1986, North Putnam Community Schools are required to annually notify all school building occupants, or their legal guardians of the availability and location of the asbestos management plans and of any post response action activities, including periodic re-inspections and surveillance activities that are planned or in progress.

In May of 2013, the school system employed universal of Indiana Inc. to conduct asbestos inspections of all the school buildings in order to update and make corrections to the management plans. These inspections were completed in May of 2013.

The school system must appoint a designated asbestos person or hire a designated asbestos person to perform asbestos duties.

On or around November 1<sup>st</sup>, renovations will be performed at the Roachdale Elementary School. An IDEM accredited asbestos company is hired to perform any and all asbestos abatement procedures necessary.

The management plans are available for public review at the administration office. This notice satisfies the annual notice requirements for North Putnam Community Schools under the AHERA standard.
