



decision on what is best for students. Committee members discussed some of the research that was available. This research indicated that there was a significant achievement loss during each transition year that students made while in school. The same study found that some students regained what was lost in the following year, but students who made fewer transitions needed fewer years to make up for achievement loss. Of the 305 people who responded to the Attendance Center Survey, 107 (35.7%) were in favor of Attendance Centers, while 193 people (64.3%) were against the idea. Attendance Center Committee members recommended that the Board not pursue the creation of attendance centers at this time.

B. “Fill the Bus” Campaign:

Because of the success of this project, there were 7,500 pounds of food collected for distribution to local food pantries in the county. Randy Neeley was very proud of the schools collaboration and contributions to this project. Dr. Lovejoy commented that we should be very proud of the students, staff, bus drivers, and administrators for all their hard work. Randy Neeley provided a video showing the bus filled with food and the all the volunteers who donated their time. Mark Hoke commented that the Bainbridge Food Pantry was overwhelmed by the amount of food they received, and they wanted to thank everyone for their generosity.
